Security products page layout.

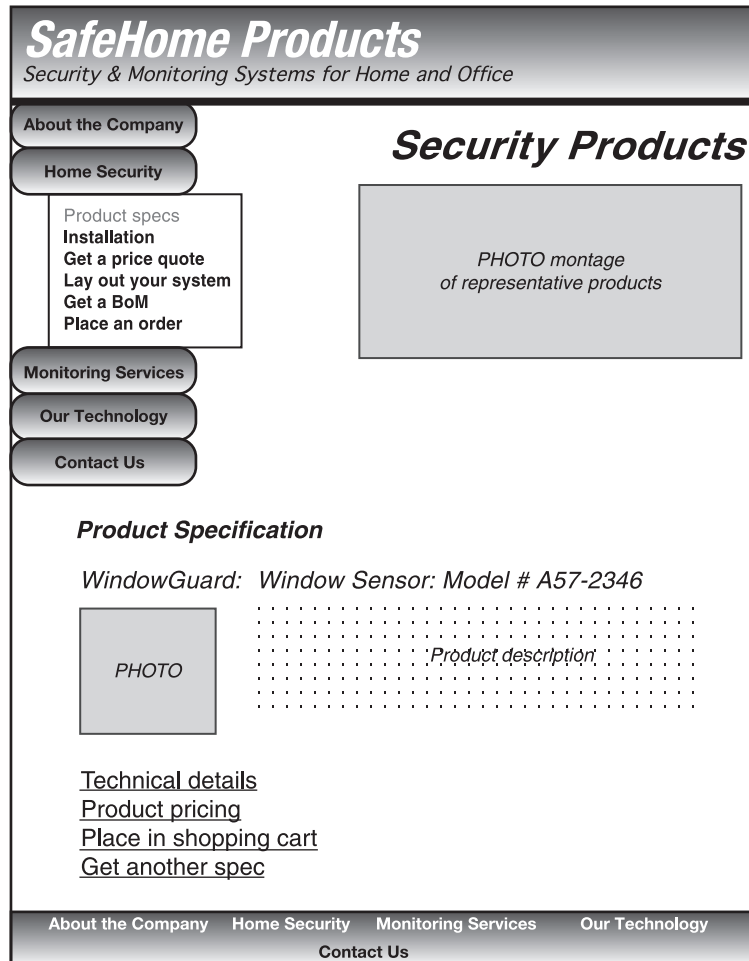


Figure 9.1, though navigation menus⁷ are expanded to reflect the tasks that will be applied to the **Component** (product specification) content object. The product name, category, part number, description, and photo are represented as shown in the figure.

Applying the design principles discussed earlier in this chapter, the interface design encourages ease of understanding and use. For example, rather than
